

## CSR Report

### Summary:

Avantsar Sdn Bhd had successfully conducted its first CSR activity at Persatuan Syukur Penyayang Pulau Pinang (PSPP) on 22 July 2023, in conjunction with the celebration of SOP 55<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. PSPP is a non-profit organization based in Penang that offers free accommodation and meals to single elderly aged 60 years and above, who are less fortunate, homeless, abandoned, or helpless.

We have visited the site at 9.15 am. A brief introduction on Avantsar and SOPB was given to the Center's founder, Mr Peter Tan. Mr Tan also shared his journey of setting up the homes since 18 years ago and their current status after several relocation due to floods and rental issues. Their current site is rented from the Penang State's Government and has been at the present site for around 3 years now. Currently, they have 41 elderly at their center with more than 10 staffs working together to provide some comforts to the single elderly that needed them.

During this visit, we have conducted blood pressure monitoring and blood sugar testing to all elderly at the center. Also, we have donated some daily supplies that are required by them, including diapers, gloves, milk powder, milo powder and disposable underpad. We have left the center at 11.30 am.
